His Unsearchable Riches

I feel impregnated with thoughts of Jesus. It is amazing that we live most of our lives not really knowing Him, not really understanding what His life brings to us. I do not know how it is that I have lived being satisfied with what little I have known of Christ. I am at a place where I deplore our lack of knowledge and understanding of Jesus our Lord. When we do not know the truth about something, we can go about daily living feeling so blissful, so content. But when we come to know the truth, it changes our life. The Scripture says, "*My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.*"¹ We are dying with a smile, and it is not because we know; it is because we have no clue why we are here and what our purpose is.

If I were to tell you today that heaven is not my goal, would you think I was apostate? Heaven is NOT my goal any more. Church is not my goal. JESUS IS MY GOAL: knowing Him, pursuing Him, grasping Him. How can we read Scripture and not see Him on every page?² How is it that we find method and reasoning and not see this Man? The whole Bible has been written about A MAN WHO IS EVERYTHING.³ Our Father God, Who is Spirit, Who is Creator, gave us Himself in a Man.⁴ The Son of God is not a little part of God.⁵ The Son of God is God,⁶ and He has been given to us with this Divine purpose in mind: that God would have fellowship with you and me forever!⁷ Therefore, we must understand THIS MAN and all that He is.

This Man Jesus Christ was not given to us to HELP us out a little bit when we try to do things such as learn mathematics or chemistry, fly an airplane, drive a truck, be a better husband

or a better wife. No, THIS MAN was given to us to make us sufficient for all things by the power of His life in us. If we actually apprehend, lay hold of, THIS MAN, then we become adequate in WHATEVER is before us.⁸ I have heard people say things such as, "weak people use Jesus as a crutch." That is such a ludicrous, nonsensical statement for any sane or spiritually cognizant person to ever make. I do not need Jesus as a crutch; I need Jesus because

He is my life.⁹ A crutch helps me to do something a little easier, but Jesus is "my doing."¹⁰ He is my enablement.

Everything is OF Him, Through Him, and To Him

Now, I realize the Spirit of God is a helper. He is a paraclete in that He comes to our aid in times of need. We need to understand that Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, is the Paraclete¹¹

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Who comes to our aid without our prompting. We sometimes forget that He is the One who has given us the desire for Him. He is the One Who has given us the will to call on Him. He is the One Who is actually doing it all; everything is of Him, through Him, and to Him.¹² THIS IS THE TOTALITY OF LIFE! We have been given this tremendous gift, this awesome blessing, and yet we are asking, “What else God?” NOTHING ELSE!

We are waiting somehow to experience “something” and then we think God is going to change us. We have already experienced the Holy Spirit, the life of God, coming into us.¹³ If we never get hold of what that means for us, then we are not going to ever realize the change He makes in us. If the dying of the Lord, the death of Jesus, the resurrection of Jesus, His ascension, His giving us gifts has not changed us, then we are not going to be changed; that is the bottom line. However, the reality is that we personally are being changed, not only day by day, but moment by moment. We are all in a process of change,¹⁴ and God is taking us slowly through this process so that we do not lose anything. He is an awesome God, “*who has blessed us*,” the Bible says, “*with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places.*”¹⁵ I am not waiting to have eternal life;¹⁶ I am already experiencing it. We are already experiencing it.

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In our humanity, we want to use God. Our carnality and childishness cause us to look at God and the things of God in a humanistic manner. While we decry humanism in our schools and nation, we view the Lord through our senses. We should not do that because the Bible says that “*God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth.*”¹⁷

Jesus Christ is the most awesome gift¹⁸ that God has to give us. God has nothing to give us outside of Himself, so whatever He gives us comes from within Himself.¹⁹ The faith you

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have, the smile on your face, EVERYTHING you have comes from God. In Spanish, the word “de” means “of or from.” Therefore, when one comes FROM Him, he is also OF Him.

You are OF God and FROM God.²⁰ You cannot really, in a true sense, be OF God if you are not FROM God. We should meditate on this truth. We are OF God because we are FROM God. We have literally, LITERALLY, LITERALLY, ACTUALLY been born from heaven! As a believer, you have been born from heaven. Perhaps, today, you do not feel like it, but how you feel has absolutely, unequivocally NOTHING to do with it.

Is it not amazing that something outside of you is trying to negate what God Himself has put inside your heart? It cannot do it. It CANNOT do it! *A righteous man may fall seven times*, and he will get up every time.²¹ Why? Because there is nothing outside him that can cancel or negate what God placed inside

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him. We must understand this awesome truth, this great blessing, this reality of God that is in us, and rid ourselves of natural thinking.²² It is amazing that we sometimes think more of what the world thinks of us than what God thinks of us. We ought to give ourselves with total abandonment to Jesus, and say, “Lord, whatever we are, we are Yours,” as did the people in Scripture who came to David saying, “We are yours, we have come for peace, we have come to do the will of God.”²³

He Has a Body in the Earth Doing His Business

The apostle Paul blesses me as I understand how he saw himself fulfilling Scripture. Isaiah 49 says, “*I have set you as a light to the Gentiles that you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.*”²⁴ Paul saw himself fulfilling this verse. This is clearly a Messianic Scripture. We are His body.²⁵ We are bone of His bones and flesh of His flesh.²⁶

Without doubt, God has written in the Bible things concerning you and me. This must bless you and excite your heart. I think we can see destiny and predestination written all over that. As Paul says, “[we] *are not mere men,*”²⁷ not just some folks who “happened”²⁸ to get saved, who “happen” to be going to heaven, who “happen” to get help from God every millisecond. We are people of destiny,²⁹ people who are in union with God right now.³⁰ We are not GOING TO BE in union, we are RIGHT NOW in union with God. We are the body of Christ on the earth. Jesus is sitting on the throne of the Father and is ruling the universe.³¹ HE HAS A BODY IN THE EARTH DOING HIS BUSINESS.³² We are that body!

This is a mystery of God, the mystery of Christ.³³ But the knowledge of Jesus removes the veil of mystery.³⁴ I used to wonder why the writer of Hebrews talked about *entering behind the veil.*³⁵

He did so because when Jesus died, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom³⁶ without human hands. God was making for us a way to Himself through the veil of the Body of Jesus Christ. WOW! We enter into eternal life through the Body of the Lord. When the Roman’s spear

pierced His side and cut His flesh open, a birthing took place for you and me that was a REAL birth. God showed it: blood and water. Birth took place when we entered the veil. Entering the veil is in a sense being privy to His mystery.

We enter the veil, a place where ordinary men and women cannot go. We enter into a realm that is a mystery to everyone else. We enter into a place where we sit down with God.³⁷ We do not need to wait to sit down with God one day in heaven. WE SIT DOWN RIGHT NOW IN THIS MOMENT WITH GOD THROUGH CHRIST JESUS. We commune with the

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Almighty God through His Son Jesus and by the Holy Spirit. We have His Reality living inside our hearts. I do not know how a person can get closer than that! Many of us are waiting to see Him outside of ourselves, but if we cannot see Him inside our hearts, we may never appreciate the One we call God. He has done something for the Church that is so beyond awesome. It is so amazing, and I cannot believe that I have not been able to see it before now. We have been given the opportunity to lay hold of the Lord and have not done so. What do you do when you come face to face with God, when not only you embrace Him, but also He embraces you?

The Treasure is Christ Himself

EVERYTHING that we want or need is in a MAN—Jesus Christ.³⁸ ALL that we will ever do is because of this MAN. Why do we treat HIM so casually? Why do we still want to use faith to gain things? Why not use faith to gain HIM?³⁹ Faith comes from Him alone.⁴⁰ It is of and through Him. The material things that I gain mean nothing to me. The real treasure is knowing Him. The treasure is not that He gives us things. Stuff is stuff! The treasure is He HIMSELF!⁴¹ Do you really value Him?

In Romans 11, Paul talks about you and me as so-called Gentile believers being grafted into *the root and fatness of the olive tree*.⁴² What he is saying is that God, with His tremendous wisdom, grafted us into the root and the fatness of the patriarchal blessings of Abraham. In other words, God made it possible for you and me to have blessings that He promised to Abraham. He promised them to Abraham AND TO HIS SEED, and his Seed is CHRIST.⁴³

So in the great wisdom of God, He says, “this is how all of you can have these blessings. I am going to give you to the Seed, and I am going to give the Seed to you.” So then, now we

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to KNOW
THIS MAN.

have THIS MAN called CHRIST. We have THIS MAN called JESUS. We have Him right now. So do not seek to use Him in order to get what you think is important.

Use your time to apprehend more of this Man Who is the reality of God, Who is the treasure of God. USE YOUR ENERGY TO KNOW HIM. Have you noticed what faith sermons are usually about? Faith sermons are usually about obtaining stuff. Stuff is not the treasure! Can you imagine this awesome Treasure sitting in heaven on the throne of God? I can imagine Him weeping at His body not apprehending who He is.

EVERYTHING that you want or need is in a MAN—Jesus Christ. All that you will ever do is because of a MAN.

God found a way to contain what could not be contained and placed it in a Man.

In Romans 11:25 Paul says, “*For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of*

*this mystery.*⁴⁴ He uses this word “mystery” often because the message of Christ is veiled. Many believers cannot see it because it is veiled.⁴⁵ The greatness of God is veiled even in human flesh. Paul refers to Jesus as the fullness of the Godhead in bodily form.⁴⁶ To me this is an awesome mystery because God found a way to contain what could not be contained and placed it in a MAN.⁴⁷ Can you take infinity and put it into finite form, as it were? That is what God did. He took it and put it in this Person. That is a mystery. Paul said, “*I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery.*⁴⁸ This has to do with the body of Christ, you and me, being placed into the root and the fatness,⁴⁹ which are all the blessings that God promised Abraham, the patriarchal blessings given to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, all the blessings that would be fulfilled when a certain Man came into the world. “*All the nations of the earth shall be blessed.*⁵⁰

You and I not only have inherited Israel, but rather, what we have inherited has to do with a promise that you and I received from our parent, Abraham. We have not only inherited that little piece of land, that little troubled strip, we have also inherited the earth, the universe, all that is of God.⁵¹ The kingdom is for the children of God. All of these things are ours. God has given us the whole Kingdom. It is not just a little quarter of an acre with a house on it, or half an acre with a bigger house on it. That is not what God has for us. God gave us His Son, and He says that if we will receive Him, we receive all His blessings forever.⁵² He says, “I have predestined you; I have placed you in My Son before the foundation of the world.⁵³ I have

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reconciled you to Myself through Him and by Him,⁵⁴ and by placing you in Him I am going to bring you back to Me. Now together We are going to rule the whole of creation.”⁵⁵ That is what God wants, and that is what He is saying to the body.

When God says that *the knowledge of the glory of the Lord* shall cover the earth like *the waters cover the sea,*⁵⁶ He is saying that NOTHING can stop what goes out from His mouth. The Bible says that *the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.*⁵⁷ Think about that—irrevocable! You cannot take the words when they go out of God’s mouth, gather them together, stuff them back in, and put some duct tape over His mouth. You cannot muffle God’s voice!⁵⁸ That is what IRREVOCABLE means. God has called us, and there is no devil, demon, or satanic agent that can alter or stop what God says about us. The God we serve is not a God of temporary blessings⁵⁹ Who blesses us for a while. He does not do that. He says, “if you will confess Jesus...there will become a rumbling, a shaking in your own life.”⁶⁰ It will shake you. It will save you. That same salvation will permeate your whole house.⁶¹ Your children may become disobedient or rebellious, but God says, “I will save them.” That is what God is saying to us in the scripture. But do we believe it? God says, “Johnny is going to be saved.” But all we talk about is his disobedience.

This Great Salvation

The Gospel is good news. There is, however, no good news in being saved today and lost tomorrow, or being saved as long as our performance is perfect. I am going to tell you something: you did not have the idea to get saved in the first place.⁶² It was His idea; it was a

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God idea. God saved you! And He says to you and to me, "Go tell the whole world that I died for their sin, and I want to save every one of them."⁶³ The Bible says it is not God's will that any should perish.⁶⁴ Therefore, you and I should be zealous in going to the world and proclaiming, "God wants to save you!" Go reconcile them. Tell them, "be reconciled to God. God sent His Son."

The world hates Jesus.⁶⁵ Do you know why? They hate Him because He is the only answer. They do not hate Buddha, they do not hate Mohammed, and they do not hate any other "deities" in the world. They hate Jesus because He is the only One Who deals with the LIE! There is the Truth, and there is the lie. They are diametrically opposed to each other. When the Spirit of God comes into your heart, He begins to attack the lie that is in you.⁶⁶ You need to know this. There is conflict in every believer. If you say there is no conflict in you, you are not telling the truth. There is conflict in us, and He is eradicating, digging out, and uprooting it. He is working in us *both to will and to do for His good pleasure.*⁶⁷ Our responsibility is to believe. Our part is to have faith and to trust Him.⁶⁸

Sometimes I think back on the emphasis of past teachings. I thank God that we were taught the Word of God, but the message that was preached seemed to mostly be about what YOU need to do. We heard more "YOU, YOU, YOU" in church than we heard "HIM." We heard things like, "YOU have to....YOU need to....YOU should....YOU better not...." It was

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mostly law, and law cannot save us. All law can do is make us miserable, make us look at ourselves and see hopelessness. We must not continue to allow hopelessness to take control of us because we have Hope inside of us now. I have the Blessed Hope in my heart: JESUS CHRIST! JESUS CHRIST LIVES IN OUR HEARTS! He is the One Who is working things out in us and for us.⁶⁹

Scripture says, "*How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation?*"⁷⁰ Salvation is not great as far as I am concerned if I can lose it at any moment. Salvation is not great if I have to keep it by my own power.⁷¹ Please, do not misunderstand what I am saying. If you say, "I'm saved, therefore I can live in debauchery," you are telling me that you have not understood my message nor salvation. When we really see what God has done for us, it drives us to our

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knees. It makes us say, "O my God, what a sinful person I am." It makes us say, "O God, You've done wonderful things for me, and I've not known it. I have not shown You appreciation." We never have license to sin. NO, NEVER! We have liberty, but not license.⁷² When we know what God has done for us, we become very appreciative of God. I want you to get this in your spirit. I want you to understand in your heart that this Man Jesus Christ has done great things for us and that He is all there is!

When I was a boy I remember thinking that I really did not want to go to hell. I did not want to go to any place that was very hot where I could not leave. I did not want to go there, but I was not too enthusiastic about heaven, either. I had been told that we would not have

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bodies there, that we would be formless spirits.⁷³ I did not like that idea. Therefore, heaven held little appeal for me other than I did not want to go to hell. I also did not know if I would even like to live forever because I thought I might get bored. What I did not understand was the UNSEARCHABLE RICHES OF CHRIST.⁷⁴ When the Bible talks about *unsearchable riches*, it speaks about riches that cannot be enumerated, that cannot be counted. It is talking about riches that cannot be traced out. They are too great for us to trace out. If we started counting His riches and we lived a billion years, we would still be counting, and it would be as though we had just started. In other words, God is so complete in Himself that He could give some different aspect of Himself to six billion different people everyday for all eternity, and we still would not know all about Him.⁷⁵ Do you think we will be bored? We will not be bored.

The reality is we have so secularized and humanized God that we have made Him in our own image.⁷⁶ We have to get it right. We talk about others needing to get God out of a box, and we have Him in many boxes ourselves. We seem to want to remove Him from someone else's box but not our own. A big problem is that we preach Christ by what we have experienced in life and not by what the Bible says.⁷⁷ We tend to color the Lord through our own eyes, instead of looking at Him through the lens of His own words. I am only saying that we have not told the story like it should be told. The Bible says that the *gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world...and then shall the end come.*⁷⁸ I do not think the end is coming any time soon, not until we publish the message of This Man, Jesus Christ.

We Serve a Covenant God

Romans 11:25: "For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion."⁷⁹ Has that happened, or not? People are wise in their

own opinion because they do not know the mystery. It is not unveiled to them. Christ is not real to them. When we read from Genesis to Revelation, we find that it is not about Moses, Joshua, Caleb, or Samson. It is all Christ, or it is nothing!⁸⁰ We hear stories all the time about these Bible characters and get excited, but the Bible is not about them. Every time the Scripture talks about one of them it is trying to give us some understanding of Christ.⁸¹ When the Bible talks about Samson and his great strength or how he was called of God from his mother's womb, we must know that it is teaching us some aspect of Christ Himself.

Before Samson is born, there is a prophecy given concerning him.⁸² “*From his mother’s womb he shall be a Nazirite. No wine shall you drink.*” He is to be a Nazirite totally dedicated to the Lord. “*The child shall be a Nazirite...to the day of his death.*”⁸³ But look at him. He messes up miserably, yet he is called. I am not giving excuse or exception, but God is saying something to you. He is saying, “*The gifts and the calling of God are IRREVOCABLE.*”⁸⁴ Samson keeps going the wrong way, and God keeps taking him back. And finally He says, “Okay, Samson, you want to go in the dungeon, then to the dungeon you will go, but I’ll have to go in with you BECAUSE I’M NOT GOING TO LEAVE YOU.”⁸⁵

God says, “I am the originator of this covenant. I am the protector of it, and I am the conclusion also!”

other words, God says, “I am the originator of this covenant.⁸⁶ I am the protector of it, and I am the conclusion also!”⁸⁷ You and I, however, have a new covenant, based on better promises.⁸⁸

God and Samson are in the dungeon together. One day the Philistines decide to make sport of Samson, and they send for him in order to mock God. Samson says, “Lord, You’ve been in the dungeon with me all this time. I can’t see. I’m not half the man I used to be, but just one more time I want You to show up!”⁸⁹ This is a guy who walked away, did his own thing, and chose the hard path. Now he says, “God, I don’t want to do my own thing anymore.” I’m telling you, God has the ability to bring you to a place where you say, “Not my will.” God will never leave you nor forsake you, but you can choose a difficult path.

Every time the Scripture talks about one of the Bible characters, it’s trying to give you some understanding of Christ.

“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”

If you were my child and were being disobedient, I would not kick you out of the house and say, "Get out with the heathen." No, I would take you into the back room and work with you until you were obedient. What makes you think you are a better parent than God? God does not take us and throw us away. What God does is He goes with us wherever we want to go. If we want to go into the dungeon,⁹⁰ He goes to the dungeon, but He deals with us there.⁹¹

Let us continue looking at the example of Samson. He is now about to be made sport of. He says to a young lad, "take me to those two big pillars that hold up this stadium."⁹²

And the little boy says, "Yes, Mr. Samson."

The Bible does not say this, but I think Samson says to the boy, "Son, when you take me there, run as far away from here as you can."

The boy says, "Sir?"

And he says, "Run as far away as you can. Don't say anything to anyone. Get out of here." Then Samson puts his arms around the pillars of the stadium and begins to glorify the One Who has never left him, the One Who has never forsaken him. He begins glorifying

HIM. I am sure that in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Spirit of
THE BIBLE God he begins to pull down those pillars. The Philistines who are making
IS ALL ABOUT a mockery of him have no idea that his God has never left him. They
THIS MAN, probably think his God has left him because none of the so-called gods of
CHRIST JESUS. the heathen would have gone into a dungeon to be with anyone. That is

the way the world thinks. But YOU ought not think like that. Suddenly, everything begins to move. It is the Spirit of God. It is not human flesh. It is not human hair. It is COVENANT! We serve a Covenant God. HE IS A GOD OF COVENANT!⁹³

The Bible is all about this Man, not Samson, but the One who was his strength! I have seen folks with their doctrine a little askew but who knew The Man Christ Jesus. I am not telling you that correct doctrine does not matter. I am only saying to you that I have seen people with their doctrine a bit askew; actually, I have seen one in the mirror, but they so know The Man that He shows up in spite of it. My wife and I were in a particular church once, and there was a guest preacher. I wondered why the Pastor had invited him. The guy had Abraham parting the sea, Moses offering up his son, and a few other such mess ups, but when he put the Bible down he said, "We're going to have some healing here," and I am telling you God showed up. I want you to understand that nothing substitutes for knowing Christ. If you know Him, He will work out all that little stuff. All the little stuff is not so important. It is important that you know The Man.

In Romans 11, Paul says that blindness has happened in part to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles comes in.⁹⁴ In verse 26 he says, "*And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written.*"⁹⁵ This is an ABSOLUTE STATEMENT. I want you to look at your God. TAKE A LOOK AT HIM! I want you to see the absoluteness here. When the Bible says "*It is written,*" it means

what has been written cannot be changed. You need to understand what God has said can never be altered by man.⁹⁶ God has said great things to you. He has predestined you!⁹⁷ You are not here because of your planning or manipulation, you are here because you are predestined. So get bad attitudes out of your mind. Get attitudes of superiority out of your head. All that stuff makes no sense because the brother or sister who is next to you who does not have a dime is predestined also. If you do not have this world's goods, you are still okay BECAUSE THE ETERNAL FOOD IS THE SAME!

Let us look at the absolute again. God says, "*All in Israel will be saved... 'The Deliverer will come out of Zion.'*"⁹⁸ That ought to make every believer understand that what God does for one He MUST, not should, do for all.⁹⁹ "*The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob.*" Verse 27: "*For this is My covenant with them.*"¹⁰⁰ This Man,

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Christ Jesus, says things such as: Father, it is Your will that I should lose nothing that You have given Me.¹⁰¹ Of all those You have given I have not lost one of them.¹⁰² Everyone You gave Me I will raise up at the last day.¹⁰³ Temporary pain and suffering do not nullify the

promises of God. I have some temporary pain and suffering, but sometimes when I look at others I think, I don't have any pain and suffering at all. Whatever I have is temporary, and what it is doing for me is working a far greater weight of glory.¹⁰⁴ Whenever difficulties come, we need to understand that God is working for our glory. Do not always look to be relieved from temporary pain. What we need to be successful is greater capacity for God. The way we get this greater capacity is by being stretched beyond our natural strength!¹⁰⁵

Continuing with verse 27: "*This is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins. Concerning the gospel they are enemies for your sake.*"¹⁰⁶ This scripture is saying that our inclusion in the new covenant is predicated upon God concluding ALL under sin. Israel became an enemy of the gospel so that we could be brought into covenant relationship. "*But concerning election, they (Israel) are beloved for the sake of the fathers.*"¹⁰⁷ In other words, God made them a promise. He chose them, as He chose us, before they did anything right or wrong. He chose all of us in Christ before the foundation of the world. Oh, how unsearchable are His riches!

Paul then talks about the gifts and the calling of God: "*For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy.*"¹⁰⁸ This is wisdom from God! What God did in their

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disobedience was find a way to include non-Jews in their blessing plan. He found a way to include us, a people who were without covenant! Remember, Jesus said that salvation is of the Jews.¹⁰⁹ This is why you and I can never boast against Israel. In verse 32, he says, “*For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy on all.*”¹¹⁰ That is a Scripture we should never forget. We have now received the riches of His mercy! Keep this in front of you, for when God did this, He made it, as it were, FOOL PROOF that you would be included in salvation.

How Unsearchable are His Riches

Paul, after writing these things, began a praise service. It is seen in verse 33: “*Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!*”¹¹¹

In other words, His decrees concerning our crime are so beyond our natural thoughts! That is what He is talking about. We were criminals. He gave a verdict, and He says it is unsearchable. It is so incredibly wise! It is so filled with knowledge that no one can prosecute us because they cannot follow the wisdom of God. Does it not bless you when brothers like Jude say things like, “*Now unto Him Who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you FAULTLESS*” (emphasis mine). . .¹¹² Every sinner, everyone who has ever sinned should shout, “PRAISE GOD FOR JESUS!” I believe if you knew experientially that you were slipping into hell right now, you would not be so casual. “...*Present you faultless before the presence of His glory.*”¹¹³

He says, “This Man saves so completely that there will be no one in the whole universe that can find anything wrong with you. There will not be one voice that will be able to speak against you.” That is the power of The Man Christ Jesus!

I thank God for Paul because God did something in him. And if God did that in Paul, that means that God is able to do it in you and me also. If

God can do a great work in and through one man or woman, then God can do it through any man or woman. So when we see God doing something great in one, we can lift our hands and say, “God, I’m also a candidate.”

He says, “*His judgments and His ways [are] past finding out!*” We just cannot trace His judgments! If we were trying to track God looking high and low and all around, we just could

not find Him. We could not say, "He's gone this way." We cannot track Him. He is too good for us to be able to do that. He has too many moves! We can never track God! "*For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has become His counselor?*"¹¹⁴ When we read this we have to read it with understanding. Paul is talking about a God who is so beyond anything human, beyond anything earthly, that he asks the questions, "*Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has become His counselor?*" There is no one who can give Him advice. When we think about that we understand no one can say, "Lord, why don't we do it this way? I think this is a better plan." It does not work that way.

Now watch what he says: "*Or who has first given to Him and it shall be repaid to him?*"¹¹⁵ What he is saying is that if we give God \$100 today, it is only because He has first given it to us. If we give Him a smile when we wake up in the morning, it is because He gave it to us. When we say, "I love you, God," it is because He first loved us. IT IS DIVINE INITIATIVE! Everything comes from God. Paul gets so excited that he says, "*For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to Whom be glory forever. AMEN*" (emphasis mine).¹¹⁶

God has put a MAN inside us who has conquered everything that needs to be conquered.

I believe that if we will get this message our lives will be changed. We will be so powerful because God has already put in us not just the seed of greatness, but more than the seed of greatness. It is THE MAN CHRIST JESUS! It is not as a seed that needs to be broken open and germinated, but God has put inside us a MAN who is fully grown. He has put a MAN inside us who has conquered everything that needs to be conquered. God has taken that Man through the Spirit of God and has placed Him inside our hearts. That MAN right now by the Spirit of God is working in us.

I just want to make it plain that there is absolutely NOTHING that the devil can successfully do against us. There is absolutely nothing that demons can perpetrate against our families. There is absolutely nothing that can overtake us. WHAT WE NEED TO DO IS COME TO FAITH IN GOD AND KNOW GOD. Whatever

happens to me God knows all about it and there is nothing a demon can do without His knowledge. He cannot get around God. He cannot go through Him. He cannot go over Him, nor can he burrow under Him. If anything happens to me, God knows all about it. He is able to prevent it, or He can deliver me from it. That is the story. That is our heritage. That is my heritage as a believer.

My God can never leave me. HE CAN NEVER LEAVE ME. I did not say He WILL never leave me. I said He CAN never leave me. Why? If for no other reason than this: He has given His

word. And when He speaks He cannot revoke it because what God says is irrevocable.¹¹⁷ God says, “*I will never leave you nor forsake you.*”¹¹⁸ God cannot take that back because that would cause God, as it were humanly speaking, to disintegrate and cease to be because what He says IS. God says, “*I will never leave you.*” Why would I feel alone? I am not alone. Jesus, when He was about to be crucified, was not alone. Sweat like great drops of blood was coming from His brow, but He was not alone. His disciples abandoned Him, but He was not alone. He was hanging on a cross with the sin of the world upon Him, but He was not alone. “*Father, Father, why have You forsaken Me?*”¹¹⁹ But He was not alone. He could not see the Father because of MY sin. He could not feel the Father because of MY sin. But He was never alone!

God Has Given Us Himself

Heaven is not my goal anymore. THE MAN CHRIST JESUS IS MY GOAL! The Bible says, “*There is...one Mediator between God and men, THE MAN CHRIST JESUS*” (emphasis mine).¹²⁰ When THIS MAN by Himself had purged our sins, He sat down! God did not send an army to take care of sin. He sent His Son!

God did not send an army to take care of sin. He sent His Son! There was one sin problem, though there were billions of people. God sent one MAN: He sent Himself. The Bible shows us in the

Book of Genesis that *the seed of the woman is going to crush the head of the enemy*¹²¹ and that *God will provide for Himself the Lamb.*¹²² What God did was reach into Himself and bring out everything we would ever need. What God has done for you and me is give us Himself in Christ Jesus. You are not going to get anything better than that. Believers need, right now, to see Jesus revealed. You and I need to know who Jesus is FOR us and IN us. We need to understand what His life brings to us.

If you desire to walk in this reality, all you have to do is ask God to reveal Jesus to you. All you have to do is ask Him to work this work in you. He has already given you the faith you need because the faith God gave you is OF Himself. He has given you a part of Himself called FAITH. If you are willing to use it, your life can begin to change right now. That is why Jesus

If you are willing to use the faith God has already given you, your life can begin to change right now.

We need to understand what His life brings to us. often says, “*if you have faith.*” He does not mean if you can find it because you already have it. He is saying, if you will use your faith, *all things are possible.*¹²³ If you can learn to exercise that part of God that is in you, there is nothing outside of God that can stand up to you. So when someone comes to you and says, “Pray for me,” you can reply, “Okay,

but I want you to exercise faith.” I believe there is a place where we have to help people by believing for them, but what God is trying to get us to do is to exercise what is in us. As we exercise what is in us, we become stronger and stronger. We begin to realize nothing is impossible because we are now operating like God operates. Please, that is not blasphemous. We do begin to operate like God operates, that is, we begin to imitate Him.¹²⁴ What God wants to see is His kids operating like He operates. I remember when I used to watch my son play football. I was more excited about watching him play than playing myself. I used to tell everyone, “there is no one like my boy playing football.” That is what God wants to do with us. He wants to look at us and get excited and say, “They did it just like I do.”

I want you to make a declaration with a loud voice. Say:

I AM A SON OF GOD! I HAVE THE LIFE OF GOD!

I CAN DO WHAT GOD SAYS I CAN DO!

I AM WHO GOD SAYS I AM!

When we say the same thing as God says, we will have what we say.

So we must keep believing what God has said. He has given us everything we need. He has given us His Son Jesus Christ Who is everything! We need to apprehend Him as our treasure, as our goal, as God’s unsearchable riches.
